

Casey used an airplane spin, sleeper hold and a pile-driver on his opponent. Lombardi executed a back-breaker and some good chops to the throat/chest area. The finale came when Scott grabbed Steve from the back of the neck. Scott then jumped in the air, holding on to Steve, and executed a bulldog. Lombardi was then on the mat floor. Casey, then, wasted no time and pinned his opponent. This was a good opening match.)

Don "The Magnificent" Muraco W. Cowboy Bob Orton, Jr. (This match was very good, with lots of action. The match started with Orton taking charge. Orton executed a very good pile-driver on Muraco and other good moves. Don threw Orton out of the ring, onto the arena floor. Don, then, left the ring. Both men, at this point, fought like dogs on the arena floor. When they got back into the ring, Muraco used a spinning toe hold on his opponent. Bob left the ring once again, only to return with a chair that he used on Muraco. The finale came, when Orton executed a pile-driver. Muraco was able to reverse it. This action stunned Bob. After he finished with Slick, he was still by the ropes, and turned around towards the middle of the ring. The Gang was waiting for him. He used a clothesline on Hogan. 
