FIRST HOUR

Sunny Beach DREW Special Delivery Jones (Beach threw S.D. into the turnbuckle and then clotheslined him. Jones gave Beach a head-butt and started to punch Sunny's face into the turnbuckle. Beach tried to pin S.D., but no luck. S.D. threw beach off the top rope and head-butted him again. Beach was trying to pick up S.D. but Jones flipped him over instead. This match went to a ten minute time limit draw. This match gets an 8.)

MATCH FOUR

David Sammartino W. The Black Panther (David executed a few arm drags. The Panther threw David's head into the turnbuckle. David executed a couple of chops to the chest and arm drag. David threw The Panther into the ring post. This action sent The Panther out of the ring. David executed a good body slam and hooked The Panther's leg after a good power slam. This match gets an 8. David looked great in action. He wrestles like his father Bruno. Time was 7:02)

MATCH FIVE

Kimala The Ugandian Giant W. Bialo The Giant (Kimala started off with chops and a head-butt. Kimala gave Bialo a foot to the stomach. This was all Kimala. The Ugandian One pinned Bialo with a big splash. This match gets a 4.)

MATCH SIX

Bam Bam Bigelow W. Sonny Blaze (Bam Bam let Sonny have it at the start. Bam Bam executed an arm bar, head-butted his opponent in the back and executed a standing drop kick. What ever Sonny tried had very little effect on Bam Bam. Bigelow executed a military press and then head-butted sonny in the stomach. Bigelow pinned Sonny with no trouble. This match gets a 4. Time of match 5:00.

SECOND HOUR

MATCH ONE

Chris Duffy W. Bull Molina (Bull executed some chops and an arm drag. Chris sent Molina flying out of the ring. Duffy pinned Molina with a back slide. This match gets a 4. Time of match 6:04.)

MATCH TWO

The Heart Breakers D.DQ. The Dark Siders (The Dark Siders came to the ring dressed as monks, with bible in hand. They prayed at the start. One of The Siders executed a double suplex. The Breakers executed some good flips. The referee disqualified both teams because he couldn't handle the action. This match gets a 6. Time of match 8:12.)

MATCH THREE

Jason The Terrible W. Bialo The Giant (Jason started to choke Bialo and stomp on him. He, then, worked on Bialo's Arm. Jason executed a good clothesline. Bialo was no match for Jason. The Terrible one finally won this match by hooking the leg. This match gets a 4. Time of match 3:10.)

MATCH FOUR

Mike Sharp D.DQ. Special Delivery Jones (Sharp elbowed Jones in the head a couple of times. Jones executed two elbow drags and an atomic knee. S.D. started to slap Sharp's in the head. Jones tried to pin sharp, but no luck. Both wrestlers were disqualified for hitting the referee. Sharp flipped Jones during the match. This match gets an 8. Time of match 7:39.)

MATCH FIVE

David Sammartino W. Gino Caruso (David did everything he could think of. David executed some good chops to the stomach and started to jump on Gino's back. David twisted Gino's arm, body slammed and pinned him. What ever Gino tried didn't work. We have to give credit to Gino for trying. This match gets a 6. Time was 8:43.)

MATCH SIX

Sunny Beach W. The Black Panther (The Panther showed of his muscles. Beach executed a back body drop. This action sent The Panther out of the ring. Beach executed a double chop to the chest. The Panther came off the top rope and tried to pin Beach, but no luck. Beach executed two Suplexes. Beach pinned The Panther after the use of a another suplex. This match gets an 8. Time of match was 7:19.)

THIRD FALL

MATCH ONE

Kimala The Ugandian Giant W. Bull Molina (Kimala gave Molina a Karate chop to the chest and a chop to the throat. Kimala won by a big splash. This match gets a 4. After the match Kimala continued his assult on his opponent. Time of match was 4:09.)

MATCH TWO

Mike Sharp W. The Black Panther (The Panther racked Mike's eyes. Sharp clotheslined The Panther and pinned him. This match gets a 4. Time was 3:19.)

MATCH THREE

The Irish Leprechaun W. Hillbilly Lou (Seeing the midgets is always a treat. Lou tried to pin The Irish One, but no luck. Lou executed a karate chop to the throat/chest and power slammed his opponent. The Irish one, finally, used a big splash to pin Lou. This match gets an 8. Time of match was 5:14.)

MATCH FOUR

John Studd W. Chris Duffy (Duffy started to slap Studd. Studd executed a good hip toss. Studd lifted Duffy off the top ring turnbuckle and then body slammed him to the mat. Studd, finally, used a rolling cradle to pin Duffy. Duffy executed some good chops. This match gets a 6. The time of this match was 3:19)

MATCH FIVE

Carmine Albano W. Sonny Blaze (Albano pinned The Blaze with a rollup Pin. This match had some good action and gets a 6. The time was 5:27.)

MATCH SIX

Bam Bam Bigelow W. Gino Caruso (Bigelow executed a good shoulder block and arm drag. Bigelow body slammed and pinned Caruso. What ever Caruso tried did no work. This match gets a 6. We didn't hear the time because the fans were cheering too loud.)

MATCH SEVEN

THIS WAS BILLED AS THE MAIN EVENT

David Sammartino W. Ivan Koloff -DQ. (David Monkey flipped Ivan. David punched Ivan and executed a knee to the stomach. Ivan tossed David out of the ring. David tried to pin Ivan, but no luck. Ivan started to punch on David's neck. Koloff tried for a suplex, but David reversed it and executed a very good suplex. Ivan executed a neck breaker. David shoved Ivan head-first into the turnbuckle. Ivan got disqualified for using his chain on David. This match gets a 9. Time of match was 9:58. This card gets a 7.)

NOTES ON THE ABOVE CARD

This card was presented and promoted by The Universal Wrestling Superstar (U.W.S.) Bruno Sammartino and Greg DeGeorge were the television commentators. This card was not bad for an independent. It was great seeing Captain Lou Albano. The Highlight of this card was seeing David Sammartino. David looked great in mat action and wrestles just like his father Bruno. Ivan Koloff is no slough, by any means. David handled himself against the big Russian quite well. It was also great to see John Studd, Kimala and Bam Bam Bigelow in action. Seeing the Heart Breakers in action for the first time, impressed us very much. We wish this new wrestling organization well in the future. The back of the program said that this card was in living memory of the legendary promoter Vince J. McMahon Sr. July 6, 1914 - May 27, 1987.

Jimmy Valiant needed only 52 seconds to beat Tim Gerrard

2ND ROUND

Jesse Ventura W. Johnny Weaver in 4:02

Blackjack Mulligan, Jr. and Big John Studd were both counted out of the ring at 12:10, thereby getting themselves both eliminated.

Ricky Steamboat w. Roddy Piper with a flying body press at 12:27. This was a very good match, but the best part of it was at the end. Piper went nuts and attackted Steamboat throwing him shoulder first into the ring post and injuring him. Steamboat was unable to continue in the tournament.

Jimmy Valiant W. Austin Idol, who was counted of the ring at 2:16.

FINAL ROUND

With Ventura getting a bye and Valiant getting a bye because of the Steamboat injury, it was rather unfortunate that two of the less impressive wrestlers should meet in the final. The final had two referees and the fact that there were two referees would be very interesting in the end. Ventura pinned Valiant and he thought that he had won the tourney, but the second referee informed the referee that made the count that Valiant had his foot over the bottom rope. The match was ordered restarted, but Ventura was so mad that he knocked out one of the referees. Finally Valiant managed to pin Ventura by using the ropes, but with one referee out this went unnoticed. All this only took 5:02. This was a tremendous ending to a tremendous tournament.
